



SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA
THE EDUCATED PATH TO INVESTING

\$1,000 UVU Scholarship Award Qualifications

The qualified student must be:

- High School Senior living in Utah County
- Scholarship money will be paid directly to Utah Valley University for the student's use.
- Graduating from high school the year applying for the scholarship
- Has completed the GFL course with no less than an "A-" grade
- Cumulative GPA of at least 3.0 through the last completed semester or quarter prior to graduation
- If available, the applicant must take and successfully pass with a score of at least 95% or better on the the Utah State GFL exam, or the National GFL Challenge Exam, if neither of these exams are available the student may submit a two page, typed, double spaced paper on why financial literacy is important (to you).
- Submitted papers must be on double-spaced and meet standard college paper submission rules. If submissions are e-mailed we prefer papers in a .pdf format to prevent tampering.
- Applicant must provide a copy of their official transcript showing the grade received for the GFL course, and GPA verification. GFL course does not have to be completed as a senior.
- If available, include an official or notarized copy of the test results for either the Utah State exam or National Challenge exam.
- Qualified Seniors must submit their scholarship application between May 1-June 15, 2011.
- Applications will not be accepted before May 1, 2011.
- Applicant will be picked by July 1, 2011 by a chosen committee.
